Summary of Position:

The Building Mechanic Technician is responsible for maintaining in good condition all mechanical systems including Heating Ventilation and Air Conditioning (HVAC) of all the local administration facilities. The incumbent also provides support in the planning of preventive maintenance and carries out maintenance tasks tied to the building mechanics of the facilities.

Duties and Responsibilities

Maintenance and repair responsibilities

- Ensure the good working condition of all local administration building mechanic systems such as heating, ventilation and air conditioning (HVAC) for the pool, arena, and other municipal facilities.
- Perform any required maintenance, including corrective and preventive maintenances as required.
- Install, repair and clean the HVAC systems.
- Provide diagnosis of electrical and mechanical faults for HVAC systems and record the results of the diagnosis, as required.
- Monitor any known ongoing mechanical systems issue and enter them in daily logs.
- Track ongoing maintenance work and the progress status, reporting and recording them.
- Identify and record any inherent maintenance risks on equipment.
- Provide estimates of maintenance and mechanical system implementation costs, as required.

Communication and reporting responsibilities

- Communicate with supervisors, directors and other employees affected by maintenance operations.
- Record daily maintenance activity in the Computerize Maintenance System (CMMS).

Additional responsibilities:

- Maintain up-to-date knowledge and skills in area(s) of responsibility through conferences and training seminars.
- Assist team members when needed.
- Perform all additional duties as required.

Qualifications:

In order to be considered for this position, applicants must possess the experience, knowledge and skills as listed below. The applicant must also be willing to attend meeting, conferences and trainings.

Education:

- Some high school diploma equivalent, with a technical certification in building maintenance and/or equivalent years of relevant experience in building maintenance.
